

# The 2018 Corinthian Friday Night Races

## Notice of Race

April 13 to August 24, 2018

### 1. RULES

- 1.1 The race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*. The Organizing Authority is CYC.
- 1.2 The Sailing Instructions will delete RRS 40 and replace with: "Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing clothing or personal equipment."

### 2 ELIGIBILITY and FLEET ASSIGNMENT

- 2.1 All sailboats eligible to race in SF-YRA, BAMA or One-Design events can participate in this series and shall have a 2018 NC-PHRF rating certificate.
- 2.2 Fleets will be defined based on entry registration, grouped primarily based on the assigned rating and may include Multihull, PHRF, J105, AE28, Non-Spinnaker, One Design, Sportboat 30 and 20something boats.
- 2.3 Final fleet assignments will be set out in the sailing instructions.
- 2.4 One Design fleets of five or more entries may have separate scoring while racing with an NCPHRF division. One Design fleets of eight or more entries received by April 6, 2108 will have separate starts.
- 2.5 Non-Spinnaker Fleet is for boats rated with spinnakers but racing without them, and specified other boats if accepted by the Race Committee. Wyliecats and similar boats shall race in the Spinnaker division. AE28s shall race in the AE28 division. All boats in the Non-Spinnaker divisions are subject to ratings modification by the Race Committee.
- 2.6 AE28 and J105 fleets are defined for their respective classes and are One Design fleets.
- 2.7 Sportboat 30 fleet is for boats with an LOA of 28ft to 38ft, NCPHRF rating of between 9 and 81, SA\_DW/D ratio  $\geq 61$ , a D/WL ratio  $\leq 121$ , that carry a bowsprit.
- 2.8 20something fleet is for boats with an LOA of 18.8 ft to  $< 30$ ft, NCPHRF rating of between 81 and 150, SA\_DW ratio of  $\geq 51$ , D/WL ratio  $\leq 124$
- 2.9 Entrants may be moved to another fleet if there are fewer than eight entries.

### 4 FEES

- 4.1 Fees for the combined Spring and Summer series will be \$165 for entries received before March 21 and \$185 for entries after that date.
- 4.2 Fees for the Spring series only (April 13 to June 8, 2018) will be \$100.

- 4.3 Fees for the Summer series only (June 15 to August 24, 2018) will be \$100.
- 4.4 Fees for an individual race will be \$50. Boats entering a single race will not be scored as part of any series.

## **5 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS**

- 5.1 The series will consist of one race each Friday, conditions permitting, with the first warning signal scheduled at 1825 hours (6:25pm).
- 5.2 The Spring Series will include races from April 13 to June 8.
- 5.3 The Summer Series will include races from June 15 to August 24 with the final race on August 24 not being scored as part of the series.
- 5.4 A minimum of three races will constitute a series.

## **7 VENUE & COURSES**

The series will take place entirely within San Francisco Bay. Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

## **8 SCORING**

- 8.1 Races will be scored time-on-time under PHRF and one design Class Rules with each series being scored separately under the low point scoring system.
- 8.2 Boats scored DNF, RET, DNS, DSQ or OCS will receive one more point than the number of boats scored as finishing in that race, and boats scored DNC will receive two more points than that number. This changes Appendix A4.2.
- 8.3 The time limit for each race will be 15 minutes after sunset as published by the US Naval Observatory [http://aa.usno.navy.mil/data/docs/RS\\_OneDay.php](http://aa.usno.navy.mil/data/docs/RS_OneDay.php). Boats failing to finish before the time limit expires will be scored DNF without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4 and A5.
- 8.4 The Spring and Summer Series will be scored separately. In each Series, there will be one throwout if fewer than seven races are sailed and two throwouts if seven or more are sailed.

**9 PRIZES**

Daily and series trophies will be awarded. A boat representative must be present to accept a Daily trophy.

**10 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance policy.
