



The 2020 Corinthian Club Championship Series Notice of Race

June 20, July 5, July 12, August 2, August 30, October 17

Organizing Authority: The Corinthian Yacht Club.

1. RULES

- 1.1. The race series will be governed by the rules as defined in US Sailing *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. The Sailing Instructions will delete RRS 40 and replaced with: "Competitors shall wear personal flotation devices at all times while afloat, except briefly while changing clothing or personal equipment."

2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY and FLEET ASSIGNMENT

- 2.1. Entry is open to members of the Corinthian Yacht Club. The skipper of a boat shall be a member of good standing.
- 2.2. Entry is open prior to each race and is considered to be entry for the remaining races in the series.
- 2.3. All sailboats not entered in a One-Design fleet shall have a 2020 NC-PHRF rating certificate.
- 2.4. Entries will be submitted through the on-line form available on the CYC website event page.
- 2.5. Boats shall race in and will be scored as one division.

3. FEES

- 3.1. There is no entry fee for this race series

4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

- 4.1. The series will consist of the following event formats commencing at 13:00hrs unless noted.
 - 4.1.1. Winward/Leward style
 - 4.1.2. Circumnavigation of Angel and/or Alcatraz Islands
 - 4.1.3. Pursuit Race
- 4.2. A minimum of two races will constitute a series

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. Series Sailing instructions (SI) will be available by June 18, 2020 on the event web page <http://www.cyc.org/racing>.
- 5.2. Each regatta may have supplementary addendums to the Series SI's which will be posted as amendments. These will be posted by 1700hrs on the Thursday preceding each Regatta on the event website.
- 5.3. Additional amendments may be posted at any time by the Organizing Authority and will be posted on the event website.

6. VENUE & COURSES

- 6.1. Racing shall take place in the San Francisco Bay and Bay entrance.
- 6.2. The start and finish will be in the vicinity of the CYC Club House.
- 6.3. Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. Races will be scored as specified in the Sailing Instructions.
- 7.2. Each race day is considered a race event. Days with multiple races will be scored as a single event using an average of the results for the races scored.
- 7.3. If more than five events are scored, a boat's worst event score will be disregarded for the series score.

8. PROTESTS

- 8.1. Protest hearings may be held by a video or other conference forum at a time agreed by the protest participants.

9. PRIZES

- 9.1. Prizes will be awarded after each race.
- 9.2. The Series Trophies will be awarded at the Annual General Meeting.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY & INSURANCE

- 10.1. Competitors participate in the regatta series entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4 – Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the regatta events.

11. INSURANCE

- 11.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with a valid third-party liability insurance policy.
